

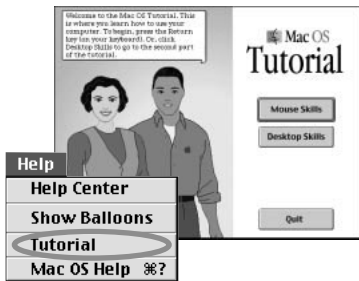

Learning the Basics

If you're new to the Macintosh, you may want to go through the Mac OS Tutorial to learn basic Macintosh skills. To do this, move the mouse so the tip of the arrow is on "Help" at the top of the screen. Press and hold down the mouse button. In the list that appears, move the arrow until "Tutorial" is highlighted, then release the button. Follow the onscreen instructions.



Registering Your Computer

In most countries, you can register your computer and other Apple products using the World Wide Web. You need to connect a phone line to your modem or connect to an Ethernet network with Internet access and enter information in the Internet Setup Assistant. Then double-click the "Register with Apple" icon on the desktop and follow the onscreen instructions.

To register your Apple products online in the future, open the Apple Extras folder on your hard disk, double-click the "Register with Apple" icon, and follow the onscreen instructions. To register through the mail, use the registration card that came with your computer.



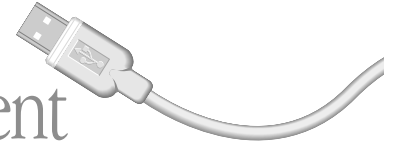
Getting Help

If you experience a problem or need help while using the Mac OS, open the Help menu and choose Mac OS Help.



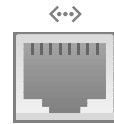
Using Your iMac

The majority of information about using your computer is available online. To access this information, open the Help menu and choose Help Center, then select About Your iMac.



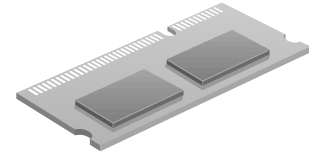
Connecting Equipment

To learn how to connect equipment, such as a printer, to your computer, open the Help menu and choose Help Center, then select About Your iMac. In the list of topics, click “Connecting equipment.”



Transferring Information

To find out how you can transfer information between computers, open the Help menu and choose Help Center, then select About Your iMac. In the list of topics, click “Transferring information.”



Installing Memory

To learn how to install additional memory in your computer, open the Help menu and choose Help Center, then select About Your iMac. In the list of topics, click “Installing memory.”
